



Environment, Health and Safety Policy Statement

When undertaking our business activities of nuclear fuels recycling contracts and transport services for global customers, health, safety and protection of the environment are of paramount importance to INS.

As an international company, INS has a vision to be known for sustained excellence in safety and environmental performance – both now and in the future. This vision will be cascaded down through our subsidiaries and those engaged to act on our behalf. We will work with our employees, customers, regulators, stakeholders and suppliers to achieve the company objectives; to protect health, prevent injury and incidents, reduce damage to the environment, and learn from events both external and internal including shared positive and negative practices.

INS transports radioactive substances worldwide. We will ensure radiological and nuclear safety by identifying and managing hazards and by using controls to prevent and limit exposure to radiation and contamination. Because the unforeseen may occur, reliable and effective emergency arrangements will be in place.

The INS strategy to achieve excellence encourages innovation and improvement by providing clear and uncompromising leadership that actively promotes a positive EH&S culture and safe behaviours.

We employ simple but efficient management systems, which govern all aspects of our business and ensure EH&S controls are effective and adequate to comply with and, where reasonably practicable, surpass legislative and regulatory requirements.

Performance will be addressed through measurement, monitoring, audit, inspection and observations. Ensuring continual improvement will be achieved by setting realistic targets on health and safety performance, prevention and reduction of environmental impacts. INS recognises that delivery of its policy relies on its management, employees and contractors. The importance of consultation at all levels with people working in partnership, questioning and challenging each other, in pursuit of EH&S excellence is a core value. To sustain this excellence, INS will provide employees with appropriate information, instruction and training to ensure a competent workforce who understand and deliver their obligations and responsibilities under EH&S legislation, INS policies and procedures.

By implementing our policy and identifying and managing the hazards presented by our activities, INS strives to ensure the safety and welfare of our workforce and those reasonably foreseen who may be affected. We will strive to prevent all incidents, including occupational accidents, injuries and ill health, impacts on the environment. Through the proper controls, we will ensure the nuclear safety, containment and management of nuclear material entrusted to us.
