When undertaking our business activities of providing specialist nuclear services for the NDA and global customers, health, safety and protection of the environment are of paramount importance to INS.

As an international company, INS has a vision to be known for sustained excellence in safety, health and environmental performance – both now and in the future. Proactive challenge is encouraged and continuous improvement will be achieved by setting realistic targets on health and safety performance and the prevention and reduction of environmental impacts.
